**Prospectus for Admission to B.Pharm Course in Lisie College of Pharmacy- Kochi-28 for
the Academic Year 2018-2019**

Introduction

Lisie College of Pharmacy is one of the premiere subsidiary units of Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, a Registered Charitable Trust belonging to Christian Minority Community owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam- Angamaly.

The college has its own policies of reservations in admitting students. However, considering the time lapse in the admissions for the year 2018-19, we are not insisting on implementing the reservation policies for this year. Selection of candidates will be purely on merit basis.

This prospectus relates to admission to B.Pharm course in Lisie College of Pharmacy, Lisie Medical and Educational Institutions, Vennala Campus, Vennala High School Road, Ernakulam, Kochi-682028.

This prospectus sets out the rules and regulations for selection and admission to B. Pharm course only for the academic year 2018-2019 in Lisie College of Pharmacy.

This prospectus is subject to modification/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the said institution and also subject to further orders if any passed by courts of law.

Eligibility For Admission

Candidates must be citizens of India/Children or dependents of Non Resident Indians.

A candidate who has undergone any of the following courses and passed the examination with an aggregate of 50% marks in overall and 50% marks in the optional subject.

a) Higher secondary examination of Govt. of Kerala with Physics, Chemistry & Biology/Mathematics/Computer Science/ Biotechnology as optional subjects

b) Any other Examination with Physics, Chemistry & Biology /Mathematics/Computer Science / Biotechnology as optional subjects approved as equivalent to any of the above examinations by the Kerala University of Health Sciences.

Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

Candidates who have passed their qualifying examinations from the states other than Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of qualifying examination.

Age

The applicant should have completed 17 years of age as on 31.12.2018. There is no upper age limit for B.Pharm course.

How to Apply

The prospectus along with application form can be obtained directly from college office on payment of Rs.500/- or by sending a request along with a D.D. for Rs.550/- drawn in favour of the Principal, Lisie College of Pharmacy, payable at Kochi. Application form can also be obtained from following branches of South Indian Bank (SIB) by payment of Rs.500/-

1. SIB, Kaloor- Lisie Hospital Extension Counter/ SIB, Palarivattam/SIB Vennala.

Application forms may be downloaded from website www.lisiecp.in. Candidate is directed to submit D.D. for Rs.500/- in favour of the Principal, Lisie College of Pharmacy, Kochi.

The application shall be submitted as detailed below.

Completed applications should be submitted to the college either by registered post or by hand. Applicants shall obtain acknowledgment from the college office, if the application is submitted in person.

Applications submitted should be complete in all aspects. The candidate should fill all the items in the application form in his/her own handwriting.

Documents to be submitted along with the application form

1. Copy of Marks Cards (Self attested) of Qualifying examinations (XII/VHSC).
2. Copy of the SSLC Certificate (Self attested) to prove date of birth.
3. Copy of Character and Conduct Certificate (Self attested).

Procedure for Selection

Selection will be on merit basis calculated on the total marks obtained in Physics & Chemistry in the second year of the qualifying examination. In case of a tie, marks obtained in chemistry will be considered, if there is still a tie, marks obtained in English will be considered, if there is still a tie, the candidate with higher age on the date of counseling will be considered.

Furnishing false information or particulars would result in the forfeiture of admission to the course. In addition; it will invite the relevant provisions of the criminal law of the land.

After scrutiny of applications, merit list will be published in the notice board of the college and on website of the college.

Admission.

For genuine reasons, management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible.

Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the Tuition fee, Caution Deposit and special fee etc. failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled.

SC/ST candidates will have to pay the normal fees. The fees will be refunded as and when the Government reimburses their fees to the college.

Discontinuation of course and payment of liquidated damages

If an admitted candidate leaves the college after the notified closing date of admission, the candidate has to pay liquidated damages to the tune of full fee of the course. The student shall be entitled to claim TC and other Certificates only after clearing all the dues.

Code of Conduct.

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution where the candidate has taken admission.

Caution.

Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging/ any type of misconduct towards any students either in the college campus or outside will be considered as a criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their study.

Every student shall at the time of admission furnish a character certificate from the institute where from he/ she has passed the qualifying examination/the course last attended. Such a certificate should mention the status of his / her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she had displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others
