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GREETINGS.

Few months back we were witness to history being made, as Lisie Hospital became NABH accredited. After months and months of preparation we finally got the much awaited NABH accreditation. Now NABH has gradually started receding from our memory lanes. It should not be so. The importance of NABH can be understood only if we know about the The Kerala Clinical Establishments (Registration and Regulation) Act 2018.

The Kerala Clinical Establishments (Registration and Regulation) Act 2018 provides for registration and regulation of clinical establishments in Kerala.

The objective of the Bill is the improvement of public health by prescribing basic minimum standards for different categories of clinical establishments to ensure the provision of proper quality healthcare by the clinical establishments.

The following are some of the features of this Act:-

All systems of medicine –Modern Medicine, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Siddha, Unani come under the purview of this act. Exceptions are Defense establishments and those offering 'Consultation Services' only.

The process is web/software based and all data will be under public domain.

District Registration Authority [DRA] is the key implementing body, which will have Collector as chairperson and DMO as vice chairperson and others.

THE DRA will grant registration, enforce compliance, conduct inspections and cancel registration.

All Government clinical establishments also should be registered as per this Act. As the entire process is web/software based, to start with, the Act will be implemented only in Thrissur, Palakkad and Malappuram districts. There is Provisional registration which is valid for two years and Permanent registration which has a validity of three years. There will be inspections to check compliance to standards and on receiving a valid complaint. Inspection will be conducted once in two years.

Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of this Act will be liable to monetary penalty ranging from 10,000 to 5 lakh rupees or closure of the clinical establishment. The most salient feature of this Act is that there is NO INSPECTION FOR ESTABLISHMENTS WITH NABH ACCREDITATION WITHIN THE VALIDITY PERIOD.

So let us be more vigilant and more diligent. Let us not lose our hard won NABH Accreditation.

Let the New Year bring good tidings to all of you. May GOD Bless you.

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Allergy is the abnormal or exaggerated reaction of the body to certain ordinary substances around it. Allergy can present as Allergic rhinitis (sneezing, nasal block, nasal discharge), Atopy (itching, redness or swelling of the skin) or Asthma (breathlessness or wheezing). Severe allergy can also present as Angioedema (abnormal swelling of the lips, tongue, and face) or Anaphylaxis (shock and collapse). Currently, approximately 20-30% of the population suffers from at least one of the allergic diseases.

In order to correctly manage Allergy, we need to be comprehensive in our approach. We need combined efforts from all specialists dealing with allergy, from the nose to the lungs, and we need to diagnose, treat and counsel the patients effectively. Every case of allergic rhinitis



managed early saves a patient from becoming a case of bronchial asthma. The Lisie Allergy and PFT lab was established with a view of giving comprehensive care to our many allergy and asthma patients. The Lab was inaugurated on 1 October 2018, with a blessing and prayer by Rev Fr Thomas Vaikathuparambil, Director, Lisie Hospital.

Skin Allergen Testing (SAT) is currently the gold standard for testing and treating allergy. It is costeffective, affordable to patients, and easily done. A drop of the allergen solution is placed on the skin of the forearm and a tiny prick is given. The



resulting reaction gives us a clue to the cause of the patient's allergies.

For patients in whom Skin Allergen Tests are not possible, like the very young, elderly, pregnant ladies, or those with severe skin conditions, we do Serum specific allergen testing. Drug allergy tests, especially for pre-operative patients with multiple drug allergies are also done here, to facilitate the safest possible combination of drugs to be used while they undergo the procedure. Pulmonary Function tests are also done here. We also focus on Asthma and Allergy counselling, with a special emphasis on correct usage of inhalers and sprays.

Allergy, like Diabetes, is a lifelong problem. It can come and go, and it can make a patient's life miserable. However, with the correct management, it can be well controlled.
